


MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

MESSAGE FROM SUPERVISORY COMMITTEE CHAIR

Since April 2019, our independent auditor, Griffin & Furman, LLC completed a 12-month audit covering the period of April 1, 2018 through March 31, 2019. Griffin & Furman reviews our general accounting procedures and performs various quarterly audits according to a schedule agreed upon by the Supervisory Committee. The Supervisory Committee has also conducted our own internal quarterly audits during the past year. In all of these audits, our credit union has scored well.

The NCUA Region IV conducted one audit in June 2019. The results of that audit showed that BRECO was performing very well and only minor suggestions or corrections were offered by the examiners.

The annual Supervisory Committee audit period for last year begins April 1, 2019 and runs through March 31, 2020. Griffin & Furman, LLC has once again been engaged to perform this 12-month audit and we expect their final report prior to the end of July 2020. Work on this audit is being coordinated now with our BRECO Management team, but I am confident that BRECO will score well again this year.


