

With a challenging 2021, and looming fears of a recession coupled with nearly unprecedented inflation in 2022, it was anyone's guess as to how this year was going to play out. But what an amazing year we experienced! From record loan growth to new expansion opportunities, BRECO is on the move!

We granted nearly \$19M in new loans, expanded our indirect auto lending program, and paid out nearly \$121K in dividends to our members. We actively supported several community fundraisers to combat cancer and other notable causes, granted \$2K in scholarships to graduating high school seniors, and expanded our surcharge ATM network. With a growth mindset, we were approved by our federal regulator to expand our services to over 400K potential members in the ten parish area surrounding metro Baton Rouge. As financial education is at the heart of who we are, we partnered with six local schools in teaching over 1,000 students how to make better financial decisions and had over 30K page views of our online financial articles.

As of May 2022, our independent auditor, Griffin & Furman, LLC completed a 12-month audit covering the period of April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2022. Griffin & Furman reviews our general accounting procedures and conducts various quarterly audits according to a schedule agreed upon by the Supervisory Committee. In all of these audits, our credit union has been shown to be performing well.

The last NCUA audit was performed in February 2022. The credit union performed well, with no major concerns notated. Our next NCUA audit should take place sometime during the 2023 calendar year.

Currently, the annual Supervisory Committee audit for the period of April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2023 is underway. Griffin & Furman, LLC has once again been engaged to conduct this 12-month audit and we expect their final report prior to the end of July 2023.
