

E-Statement Disclosure & Consent Form

By clicking on the "Submit" button and electing to receive your statements electronically, you agree to accept periodic statements, and all disclosures related to your statements, electronically. Electronic statements will be made available to you on or before the 2nd business day of the statement month and you understand that you will be notified via e-mail as to the availability of your statement.

You agree and understand that you will no longer receive a paper statement. Upon receipt of E-Statement notification, you will access your statement online & if you are unable to view or access your statement you will notify Breco FCU at 1-800-361-1631.

You may withdraw your consent and revoke your agreement to receive records electronically at any time by contacting the credit union at the phone number on the credit union website. A fee to cancel this service or to request paper copies of these electronic statements may be imposed as set forth in the Fee Schedule. To obtain a paper archive copy of your statement, login and view your statement, then save or print the pdf. You may also contact credit union personnel.

The files transmitted for these statements will not be used for marketing, or any other purpose, by any third party vendor.

Site Requirements

Web Browser Software

Mozilla Firefox (1.0 final release and earlier)

Go to the "Tools" menu.

Select "Options".

Click "OK" to save changes.

Netscape 7.1/Mozilla 5.0

Select "Preferences" from the Edit menu.
